

- 535 acres total
- 200 acres cropland
- 242 acres bottomland hardwoods
- 93 acres upland hardwoods
- Purchased December 2014
- Cropland to be enrolled into CRP practices to include shallow water wetlands, wet/dry prairies, pollinator planting and tree planting
- Non-native invasive species control
