

- ❖ Incorporated in 1971, Citizens for Conservation (CFC) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to *Saving Living Space for Living Things*. Now 47 years strong!
- CFC, with partners, have protected 3,500 + acres by direct acquisition, donation and conservation easements.
- Barrington Greenway Initiative (BGI) has created a strategic partnership of large regional conservation groups to leverage and deliver larger conservation success and benefits to current and future generations.
- CFC, a volunteer organization, owns and carefully manages 11 preserves totaling 435.58 acres. CFC has restoration workdays year-round, now totaling 2,500 workdays in our 31-year restoration history. In 2015, 400+ volunteers participated producing 14,000+ hours of work.
- CFC educates 1,600+ students through our 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade District programs and hundreds more through our Community Education and Youth Education programs on a wide range of subjects. CFC's Habitat Corridors is a program for residents that encourages earth-friendly practices to improve habitat and water and air quality in the Barrington area.
